- a) A first degree (MQF Level 6) in Archaeology (whether major or subsidiary);
- b) Be registered as an archaeology monitor with the Superintendence of Cultural Heritage (or have the necessary qualifications to obtain such registration within a reasonable time);
- c) Exposure to relevant work gained through practical and / or on-the-job training (including University placements); and
- d) Experience in using CAD software (or similar).

In addition, the candidate is to:

- a) Be of high integrity, accountable, well-organized, and highly motivated;
- b) Enjoy working outdoors;
- c) Thrive on working in a challenging environment with tight deadlines;
- d) Be ready to be trained in the use of new technologies, software and equipment required for the completion of the tasks assigned; and
